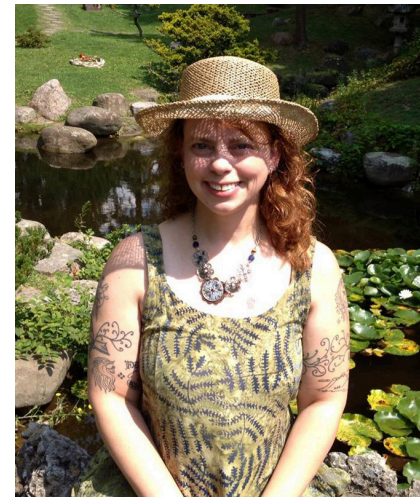

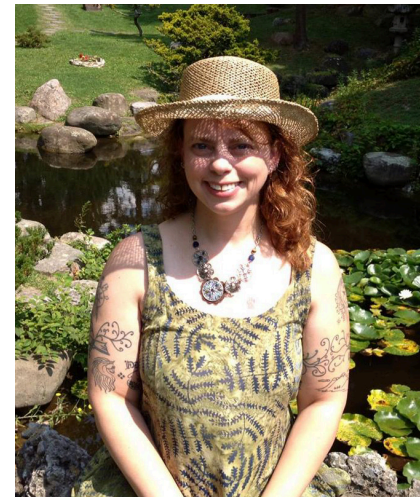

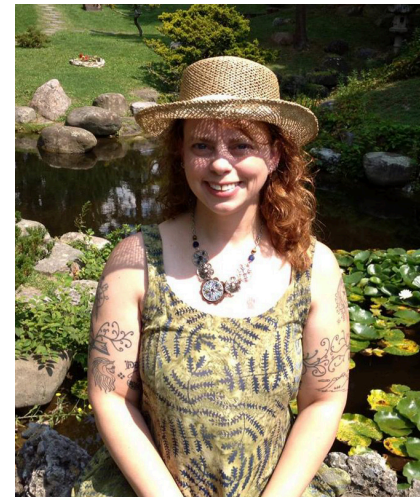
Question 1

What conflicts have you observed between the ways you determine "quality" in your blended courses and the way your organization determines quality in blended courses/programs?



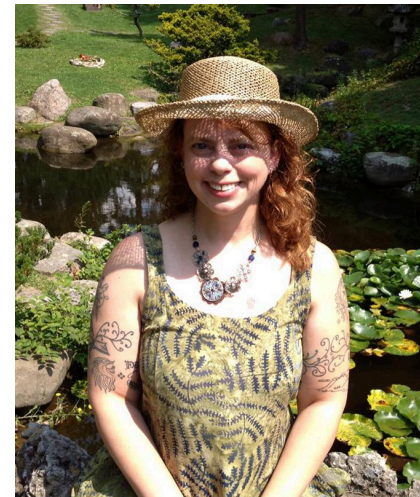
Question 2
